

Should have a separate minimum pass mark for Physics, Chemistry, and Biology, and 50% mark in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology put together.

## **Academic Eligibility for BPT Course:**

- 1. Should have passed the Higher Secondary examination conducted by the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, or an examination equivalent thereto as approved by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur.
- 2. Should have a separate minimum pass mark for Physics, Chemistry, and Biology, and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology put together.
- 3. Eligibility Certificates: Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from Schools/Boards outside Kerala State shall produce the certificate of recognition, ie, Eligibility Certificate from KUHS Thrissur.
- 4. This should be furnished at the time of the interview for admission.

# CENTRALISED APPLICATION AND ALLOTMENT PROCESS:

- The application for admission and the prospectus is available online on the college website. Visit the website for details. (www.igcp.in)
- The application fee is Rs. 2000/- for all candidates, payable online via Credit/Debit/Internet Banking.
- Applicants must have a valid email ID.
- After filling out all necessary information and uploading required marks and documents, candidates can pay the application fee online.
- The application submission will only be considered complete after successful payment of the application fee online.
- Upon successful submission and payment, candidates will receive an electronically generated receipt at their registered email address.
- After submitting the application online, candidates should print a copy which must be submitted to the Principal, Indira Gandhi College of Physiotherapy during the admission interview.
- Each applicant may submit the application online only once the application fee once paid is non-refundable under any circumstances.
- Enclose self-attested copies of the following certificates with the application form:
  - 1. S.S.L.C Certificate/Equivalent/Birth Certificate
  - 2. Plus Two Certificate/Equivalent (with mark list)
  - 3. Nativity Certificate
  - 4. Course Certificate issued by the Head of the Educational Institution last attended.
  - 5. Copy of Transfer Certificate (TC) and Conduct Certificate.
  - 6. Copy of the Equivalency Certificate and Migration Certificate (Only for candidates from outside Kerala).

- 7. Copy of Application Fee Payment Details for Admission.
- 8. Caste Certificate and Income Certificate (for candidates eligible for reservation benefits such as SC/ST/OBC/OEC/EBW, etc.).
- 9. Four Passport Size Photographs.
- Incomplete or late applications will be rejected.
- Selection Of Candidates
- Selection of candidates will be based on a merit list prepared from marks obtained in the Plus Two or qualifying examination. Candidates must bring all original documents for verification during admission. Providing false information will result in admission cancellation.
- Preparation of Merit List
- Marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and English in the Higher Secondary Examination\*
  will determine the merit list. In the event of a tie among students, priority will be given to
  higher marks in Biology, followed by Physics and Chemistry.
- If ties persist after this criterion, the candidate's Date of Birth will be taken into consideration, with preference given to older candidates CBSE / ICSE Senior Secondary Examination marks will be equated with Kerala syllabus Higher Secondary marks through an approved normalization process.
- Publication of Rank List
- Rank lists will be published on the college website www.igcp.in on the specified date.

- Selected candidates will be notified of the interview and admission dates via the website.
- Candidates should regularly visit the Official Website of Indira Gandhi College of Physiotherapy for updates and notifications. Candidates selected under the Management Merit quota must deposit fees into the designated bank account.

Conversely, if the fee fixed by FRC is higher than the proposed fee, students will be liable to remit the additional amount to the college. All fees will be collected strictly in accordance with the orders of FRC for the academic year 2025–26.

#### ELIGIBILITY FOR KUHS EXAMINATION APPEARANCE

- Candidate should have minimum of 80% attendance in theory and practical per subject is required for appearing in University Examinations. Non-exam going subjects also require a minimum 80% attendance to register for examination. If a candidate has less than 80% attendance in any subject, they will not be eligible to appear for examinations in that semester.
- Candidates must achieve at least 50% marks in internal assessments for theory and practical's (where applicable) to qualify for University Examinations. The minimum passing mark is 40% for Communicative English and Elective modules.

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. Students must adhere to professional conduct and maintain high standards of discipline.
- 2. Decorum and dignity must be maintained in the College and Hospital,
- 3. The management reserves the right, as per Clause 7 of University Rules and Regulations and judgments of the Courts, to halt student organizational activities on campus.

# **Prohibition of Ragging** GROUP O

- a.
